<u>The Gospel reading</u> <u>for this Sunday is</u> from Luke 13:1-9

Unless you repent you will all perish as they did.

Some people arrived and told Jesus about the Galileans whose

blood Pilate had mingled with that of their sacrifices. At this he said to them, 'Do you suppose these Galileans who suffered like that were greater sinners than any other Galileans? They were not, I tell you. No; but unless you repent you will all perish as they did. Or those eighteen on whom the tower at Siloam fell and killed them? Do you suppose that they were more guilty than all the other people living in Jerusalem? They were not, I tell you. No; but unless you repent you will all perish as they did.'

He told this parable: 'A man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard, and he came looking for fruit on it but found none. He said to the man who looked after the vineyard, "Look here, for three years now I have been coming to look for fruit on this fig tree and finding none. Cut it down: why should it be taking up the ground?" "Sir," the man replied "leave it one more year and give me time to dig round it and manure it: it may bear fruit next year; if not, then you can cut it down."" *Ref: Liturgyhelp.com*

Religious Education in Year 4 Term 1: Week 8

At the start of Term 1, we were busy looking at how we talk and listen to God during our daily lives. This allowed us to communicate effectively during prayer and with others in our class and school community.

Our current unit is, 'Lent: A Time for Reconciliation', which significantly focuses on the Parable of the Prodigal Son in the context of Lent and challenges and invites us to reconcile with God and others during this time. Students have specifically looked at the Parable's purpose and message, while focusing on the elements of Lent and the Sacrament of Penance.

In class, we have been completing Lenten promises, identifying significant features of the Lenten season, how Lent challenges and invites us to be reconciled with God and others and how the Parable of the Prodigal Son and The Parable of the Lost Sheep relates to our own lives.



Mathematics in the home #4

Ways to help your child learn mathematical ideas at home:



- Point out groups of objects
- Identify arrays in the environment
- Count collections
 using arrays
- Create a graph of your child's growth over time or family eye or hair colours
- Discuss and interpret tables and graphs presented in the media
- Explain information that uses terms like 'average' eg rainfall



Other ways to help your child include:

Use everyday opportunities to make mathematics visible

- Remember your child's learning may look different to yours.
- There can be a number of ways to solve a mathematical problem.
- Don't say "That's wrong", say "How did you get your answer?"
- Encourage your child to talk through their thinking
- Allow your child time to think don't rush in and give them the answer wait and listen.
- Discuss the ways in which data can be misinterpreted in the media eg bias
