Tomorrow we celebrate the Feast of the 'Presentation of the Lord'.

The Gospel reading for today if from Luke 2:22-32 (Short Form)

My eyes have seen your saving power.

When the day came for them to be purified as laid down by the Law of Moses, the parents of Jesus took him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord – observing what stands written in the Law of the Lord: Every first-born male must be consecrated to the Lord – and also to offer in sacrifice, in accordance with what is said in the Law of the Lord, a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons. Now in Jerusalem there was a man named Simeon. He was an upright and devout man; he looked forward to Israel's comforting and the Holy Spirit rested on him. It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death until he had set eyes on the Christ of the Lord. Prompted by the Spirit he came to the Temple: and when the parents brought in the child Jesus to do for him what the Law required, he took him into his arms and blessed God; and he said:

School Hours

In 2018, many children arrived <u>after</u> the morning bell on a regular basis and missed valuable lessons. Part absences are noted on the roll which is an official record of absences. It would be appreciated if students arrive at school before the 8.55am bell.

Parents must accompany late children to the office to sign the late register.

Attendance Register

An Attendance Register is a legal document that records your child's attendance at school. Please note that if your child is absent from school, signed, written notification must be sent to the class teacher. Short absences do not require a phone call to the office. A legal requirement has been put in place for schools. When parents are planning to take their children out of school for holidays or family circumstances for 5 days or more, they need to obtain a form from the office to apply in writing. The principal may grant permission for this leave.

Office Hours

The office is open from 8.30am until 3.30pm Monday to Friday.

Morning Supervision

The gates of the parish site will not be opened until 8.30am. Parents are therefore advised that there will be **NO ACCESS** to school before that time.

If you need to drop off your child earlier in order to arrive at work on time, it is your responsibility to arrange a placement with the Child Care Centre. For access to the Before and After School Care the gate near the hall will remain opened, however, only children booked in may use this entry (in the mornings, access for parents with prams etc will be after 8.30am). For information and bookings please phone 1300 553 583.

Emergencies

If your child is involved in an emergency situation, it is vital that we have access to accurate, up-to-date information. If you have changed your address, email or phone number recently, please forward the details to the office as a matter of urgency.

Visas

If you or your child has been on a Visa and the status has changed, please update our records by providing the paperwork as soon as possible.

Religion

If your child has recently been baptised, please provide the details to the school office.

Opal Bus Passes

To be eligible for a school opal card students need to live a minimum distance away from their school:

Years K-2—There is no minimum distance

Years 3-6— 1.6 km straight line distance or 2.3 km walking distance or further.

Who needs to apply

An application is needed if your child has not had a travel pass before or if you have changed address.

How to apply

Step 1

Complete the application at transportnsw.info/school -students

Step 2

The school endorses your application.

Step 3

Once Transport for NSW has approved the application, a School Opal card will be sent to the address provided on the application.

Newsletter Items

Families are encouraged to advise the office by **Monday** of any items of interest for the weekly school newsletter e.g. birth notices. The newsletter is compiled on Tuesday and will be emailed on **Friday.**

Medication

Unless on the advice of a doctor, children are not to carry medication AT ANY TIME as this could accidentally fall into the wrong hands. Parents whose children require regular medication are to complete forms (available from office) and supply to the school, <u>in writing</u>, clear instructions regarding dosage and time to be administered. If your doctor has recommended that your child carry asthma medication e.g. puffer, please write a note to the class teacher. Parents of children with other medical conditions are asked to liaise with the school.

Please note that the school <u>does not</u> provide 'Panadol'. Should your child require pain relief, you will be contacted to collect him/her or, alternatively, you may bring medication and administer it yourself. The school will provide Stingose for bites and stings. Please notify us in writing if you do not wish us to use this cream.

Peanut Allergy

Our school endeavours to be a peanut-free school as we still have students who display varying degrees of allergic reactions. We would ask that children **<u>DO NOT</u>** bring peanut butter, Nutella or products containing nuts to school.



Asthma Medication

If your child currently has asthma medication at the school please call into the office to check that it has not expired.

If your child has asthma and you have not completed the school's 'Child Asthma Record' please call into the office to collect one.

ALSO, for any student with a Medical Action Plan held at the school, an **updated** Action Plan with a recent photo needs to be provided each year. Please note that a doctor's signature is required on all Action Plans.



Afternoon Dismissal

Children will remain in class until they are collected by parents. If details change, ie parents organize a grandparent/friend etc to call for the children, then a note <u>must</u> be sent to the class teacher.

Walkers, bus and after school care children are permitted to leave the classroom. In the interests of safety, boys and girls are **not** to wait at the school gates. This area is unsupervised and unsafe.

Bus Supervision

The procedure for after-school bus supervision is:

- Teachers on bus duty will walk children across Windsor Rd or Oakland Ave (bus children and walkers).
- The teacher on duty will only supervise those students who catch a bus at the bus stop on either side of Windsor Rd.

This supervision will **stop** once buses have left, but no later than 3.45pm. Students catching later buses will be **unsupervised** until the bus arrives

Back to school asthma checklist



1. ASTHMA ACTION PLAN

See a doctor for a signed Asthma Action Plan or Care Plan. Most schools require an up-to-date plan for each student with asthma at the start of the new school year.

Evidence tells us that using an Asthma Action Plan can help to reduce hospitalisations, improve lung function and reduce the number of days off school.

While with the doctor, why not combine this with a check-up for your child's asthma, including a check on their device technique.



2. RELIEVER MEDICATION

Check with the school about their medication policy and work with the staff to find the best way to manage your child's asthma medication, including before physical activity (where applicable).

- Medication and devices are clearly labelled with your child's name
- Medication is in date and with sufficient medication remaining



3. TALK TO SCHOOL STAFF

Make time to talk with the class teacher and the school nurse (where applicable) about your child's asthma, their Asthma Plan and their usual triggers, symptoms and medication.

Also talk to your child's sport coaches and supervisors of other school activities. Don't forget to keep staff up-to-date with any change to your child's asthma management.

Use this valuable time to:

- O Go over your child's Asthma Plan
- O Discuss the signs of asthma for your child
- Show them your child's asthma medication and demonstrate how to use it
- Talk about the extent to which your child can self-manage their asthma
- O Provide details of how to contact you when:
 - They have asthma symptoms
 - They use a reliever medication at school









School Opal Card

As part of our campaign against fare evasion, and our on-going commitment to provide the level of service needed to transport students to and from your school, Busways conducts regular checks of School Opal card.

All students must be in possession of a valid Opal card or pay a fare.

Students in possession of an Opal card must also tap on/off with their card when boarding our buses.

This is important, because the Opal data collected determines the level of service we are able to provide to your school. If students don't tap on and off, the services will appear underutilised and may be considered for cancellation based on low passenger numbers.

How can you promote a healthy attendance culture in your school?






