The Gospel reading for Sunday is from Luke 6: 27-38

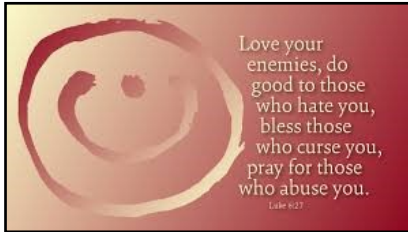
Be merciful as your Father is merciful.

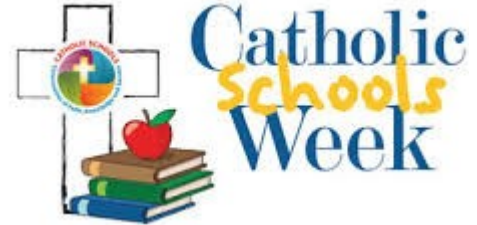

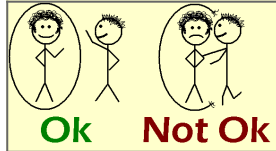
National Day of Action against Bullying and Violence (NDA)

Helpers needed for Children's Liturgy at Our Lady of Lourdes Church



Children's Liturgy is a special celebration of the weekly liturgy for children. It involves children leaving the Sunday Mass during Liturgy of the Word for a short time and gathering elsewhere to celebrate a separate Liturgy of the Word that is more appropriate to the children's level of understanding.

Leaders work in pairs on a roster system throughout the term, using prepared materials. A planning meeting is held to discuss activities and dates at the start of each term. Volunteers need a Working With Children Check as required by the Diocese for all those who work with children-we can help you with this, in need. The Liturgy takes place in the Parish Centre.

The aim of the Children's Liturgy is to make the regular Scripture Readings more accessible to children, and also to prepare them to participate fully in regular Sunday Mass. Children still need to regularly celebrate the full mass as part of the parish community - Children's Liturgy only operates during terms.

It is essential to keep in mind two key principles when preparing and celebrating liturgy of the word. Firstly, it is to be a liturgy involving reading and prayer, not religious instruction or child-minding. Secondly, as it is the Liturgy of the Word, this must be centred on proclaiming and explaining the scriptures. The children are asked to listen to the scriptures, apply them to their own life, and respond in various ways.

Readings are appropriate for children, from the Lectionary for Masses with Children. In addition to the reading, symbols, gesture, movement and singing, help to enhance the children's experience. Liturgical objects will be used to provide a focal point. **Children must be of primary school age.** Pre-schoolers must be accompanied by an adult. During their time participating in the liturgy, children will be invited to take on roles such as readers, prayer leaders, playing music and so on. Children will return to the main assembly to celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist and the remainder of the Mass.

The form of the celebration is usually as follows:

1. Procession from the Church
2. Gospel Reading
3. A homily (explanation/discussion) given by the leaders, which may be instructional, or make use of question and answer, discussion, guided reflection or silent meditation.
4. A short activity such as a song, mime, or role play to further help the understand the scripture readings.
5. Prayers of the Faithful

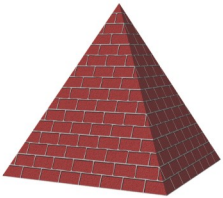

Mathematics in the home

Ways to help your child learn mathematical ideas at home:



Use the language of mathematics

- when the children are younger - under, over, bigger, smaller
- for older children - pyramid, cone, perimeter, area
- Ask your child “what if questions”

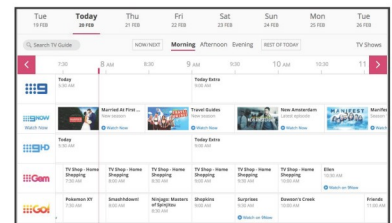
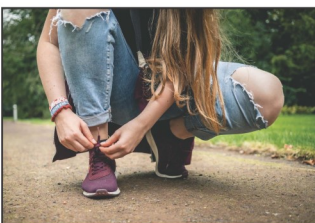


Other ways to help your child include:

- Reading bus and train timetables for reading 24 hour time
- Reading TV guides for estimating duration of programs: what time is your favourite TV show start and how long does it for
- Record special events on a family calendar and talk about how many “sleeps” for an event
- Encourage your child to estimate how long a task will take e.g., tying shoelaces, packing away their toys or books
- Discussing sporting results such as swimming or running times

Use everyday opportunities to make Mathematics visible

- Remember your child’s learning may look different to yours.
- There can be a number of ways to solve a mathematical problem.
- Don’t say “That’s wrong”, say “How did you get your answer?”
- Encourage your child to talk through their thinking
- Allow your child time to think - don’t rush in and give them the answer - wait and listen.
