RELIGIOUS EDUCATION IN THE CLASSROOM

This term, Year One are learning about bible stories in our unit called Stories of Jesus. We will explore and celebrate the stories of Jesus. The students will identify ways in which they can respond to the love of Jesus.

The students have discovered that the Bible is divided into two sections, the Old Testament and the New Testament. In the New Testament we found that some stories are *about* Jesus and others are *told by* Jesus. We call the stories *told by* Jesus, parables and they contain a message that helps us live our lives and follow His example.

The first scripture story we read is, '*The Boy Jesus in the Temple*' (Luke 2:41-52). We discussed the difference between how Jesus felt when Mary and Joseph thought He was lost and how we feel when we are lost.

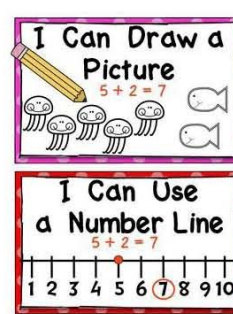
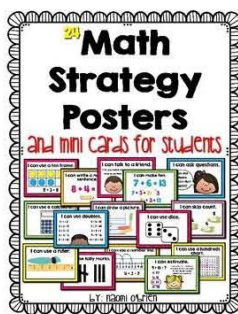
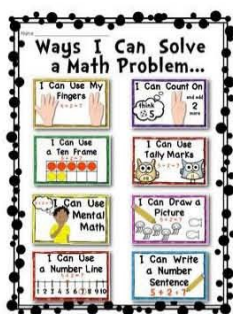
Ways to help your child learn mathematical ideas at home:

Questions to ask your child when working mathematically at home	Encourage your child to respond in these ways
How did you solve the problem?	I drew a picture that showed how I solved the problem
What strategy did you use?	My strategy was successful because.....
What maths words did you use or learn?	The maths words I used were.....
What steps were involved?	The steps I followed were.....

Other ways to help your child include:

Use everyday opportunities to make mathematics visible

- Remember your child's learning may look different to yours.
- There can be a number of ways to solve a mathematical problem.
- Don't say "That's wrong", say "How did you get your answer?"
- Encourage your child to talk through their thinking
- Allow your child time to think - don't rush in and give them the answer - wait and listen.

We normally field a minimum of 10 senior teams each year.

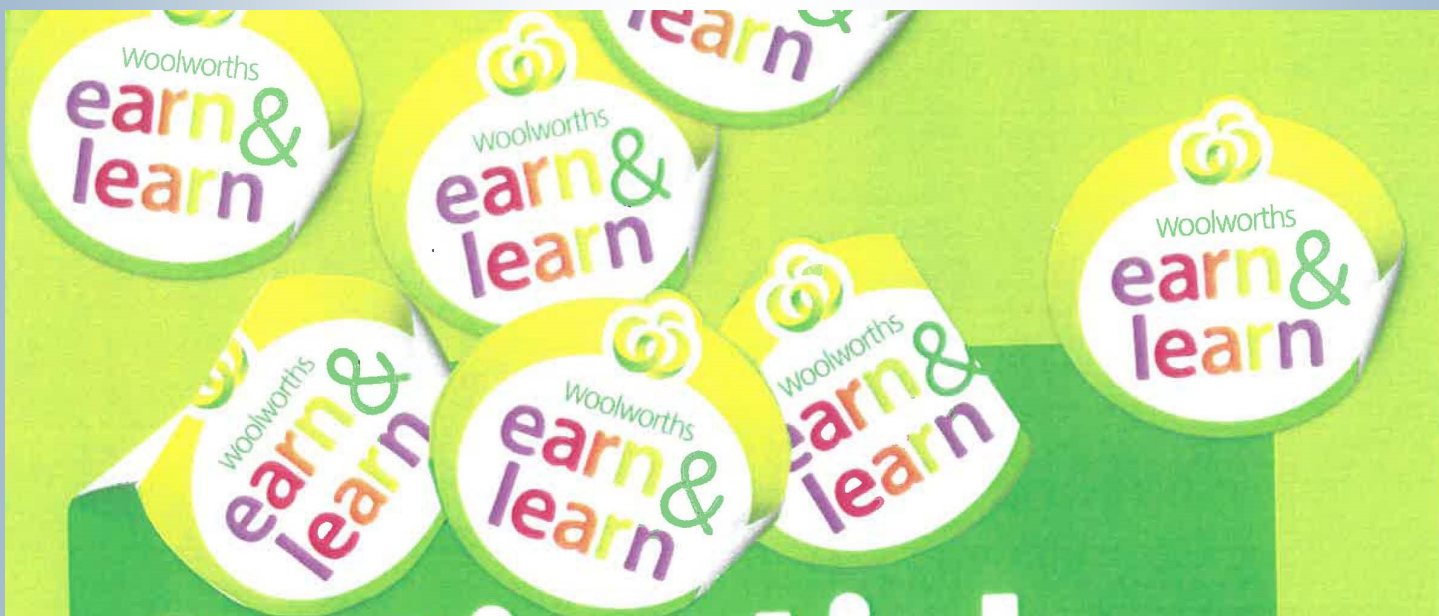

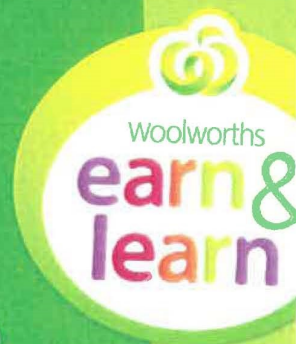
