The Gospel reading for this Sunday is taken from Luke 13:22-30

Year 5 Family/Parish Mass

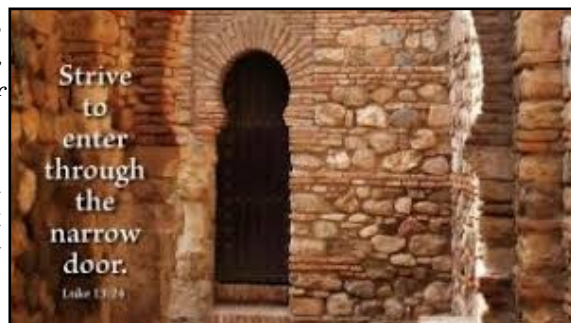

Golden Jubilee of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish Baulkham Hills

Our Lady of Lourdes Parish will be celebrating their Golden Jubilee in October. As part of their celebrations they are including "snippets from the past" in their weekly bulletin.

Parish Memories 1969 – 2019

Carolyn And David Olliffe. 1975 - 2002.

After 7 years as parishioners at St Monica's, North Parramatta we moved to Baulkham Hills and joined the Parish of Our Lady of Lourdes in 1975, with our three children attending school at OLOL. Masses were held in the classrooms that had to be set up and dismantled each weekend. Kindergarten classes were held in the cottages on Windsor Road. I also have memories of the Art Shows being set up in the cottages run by Margaret Dobson, Margaret Parr, Elsa Geale and others with many of us younger mums acting as hostesses .

When the hall was built in later years the Art Shows were held there and were a wonderful social event in the Parish. The fetes were always a successful part of parish life and great fundraisers. Father Kelly loved the fetes and would often comment "what a great way to bring the parish together". Some of the mums were playing Netball at Ted Horwood and a decision was made to start a school netball club which was received with great enthusiasm and, in 1979, teams were formed and the girls played in their yellow sports uniforms.

A couple of years later the bright yellow "buttercups" appeared on the court after a roll of material was purchased from the woollen mills and many talented and generous mums sewed the new netball skirts. That was just the start of many years of netball tradition at OLOL. When the church was being built there were many Saturday working bees to clean bricks. There was a very dedicated group of men who turned up for many weeks to ensure the bricks were cleaned and ready to be used on the wall behind the altar and other areas of the building. Our involvement with Music Ministry began way back when Elsie Walker convened the choir. Our love of Music Ministry continues to this day with our choir at Forster parish. I must make mention of Leonie Turner for her dedication to music at OLOL Parish. Leonie is probably one of the longest serving musicians in any Parish. Well done Leonie....an inspiration to us all.

The Family Group Movement was introduced to Our Lady of Lourdes in 1990. It has been a great medium for prayerful, emotional and social support for all those involved. We were there at the start and always love times shared with our family group. In the early days we shared many wonderful social gatherings ...led by John Newson and his committee of which I was a part for many years. We organised Parish picnics, car trials, dinner dances at the Dural Country Club and when the Hall was built many fun nights including theme nights, fashion parades and who could forget the many years of Parish Revue Nights.

We Thank God for all the happy years and the friendship shared at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish.

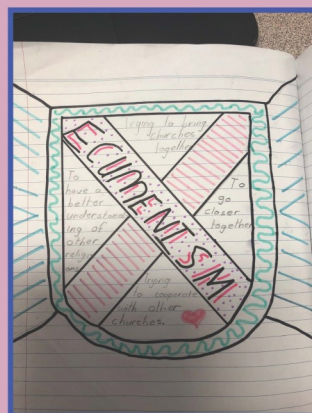
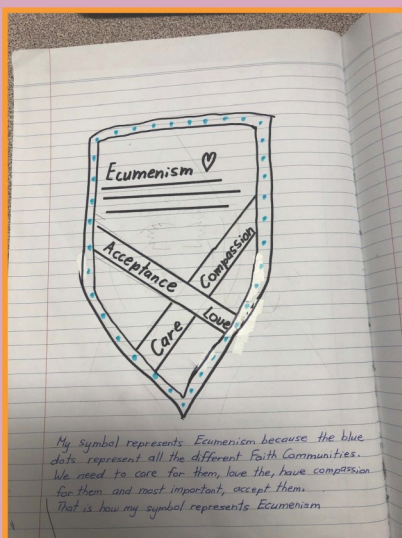
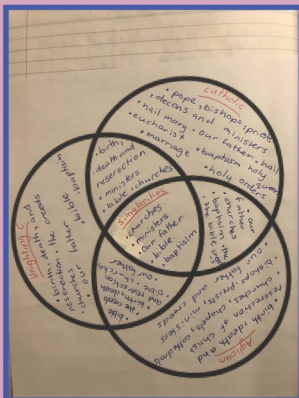
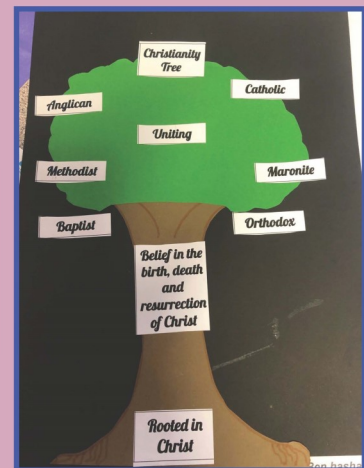
We have been learning that the Church must strive for Christian unity.

Mathematics in the home #11

Ways to help your child learn mathematical ideas at home:

Maths in the outdoors

Walking, talking, looking & listening

- Counting steps as you walk, predict how many steps each family member will need to take to reach a given point.
- Compare and contrast the heights and spread of trees.
- Discuss shapes of buildings, garden beds and fences.
- Go on a number hunt - identify numbers in the environment.
- Find shapes - create a family challenge to identify the most shapes, eg in play equipment. Describe the shapes and their properties.
- Map the path you take - describe your movements eg "Let's walk *around* the pond and *over* the bridge."

"Have fun exploring the beauty of Maths everyday"

Other ways to help your child include:

Use everyday opportunities to make mathematics visible

- Remember your child's learning may look different to yours.
- There can be a number of ways to solve a mathematical problem.
- Don't say "That's wrong", say "How did you get your answer?"
- Encourage your child to talk through their thinking
- Allow your child time to think - don't rush in and give them the answer - wait and listen.
