## 2020 Mathematics in the home #7 T2 W6

**Ways to respond to your child's mathematical thinking at home:**

- ★ Play strategy games together eg chess
- ★ Plan the family budget for a holiday - best transport / fuel costs / meals / cost of activities
- ★ Make a pizza together - how much of each ingredient / how many pieces to share equally?
- ★ Set up a scavenger hunt - create a map / write up clues / work in teams
- ★ Make up water balloons - how far can they be thrown? Measure distances and compare
- ★ Skipping rope activities - time how long you can skip for
- ★ Elastics - how high can you jump?
- ★ Look at a calendar - how many days / weeks / months until an event?

**Other ways to help your child include:**

### **Use everyday opportunities to make mathematics visible**

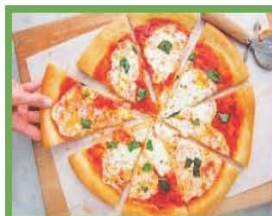
- Maths is an important part of everyday life
