## Sunday's Gospel reading. (short form)

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew

Such was said to your ancestors; but I am speaking to you.

Jesus said to his disciples: I tell you, if your virtue goes no deeper than that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never get into the kingdom of heaven.

'You have learnt how it was said to our ancestors: You must not kill; and if anyone does kill he must answer for it before the court. But I say this to you: anyone who is angry with his brother will answer for it before the court.

'You have learnt how it was said: You must not commit adultery. But I say this to you: if a man looks at a woman lustfully, he has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

'Again, you have learnt how it was said to our ancestors: You must not break your oath, but must fulfil your oaths to the Lord. But I say this to you: do not swear at all. All you need say is "Yes" if you mean yes, "No" if you mean no; anything more than this comes from the evil one.'

## Living the Gospel Reflection written by Greg Sunter -Liturgy Help.

Jesus demonstrates the crucial nature of interpretation. It is easy for us today to something like the look at Ten Commandments or the Beatitudes and dismiss them as irrelevant. Taken literally. they have fairly limited modern application to our lives. However, interpreted in a broader context and within the context of our own lives, such ancient codes of behaviour can take



on new significance. Jesus points us towards the importance of looking beyond the surface and searching out the truth of such statements. Interpretation of scripture for our modern lives and modern world is vital to living life to the fullest.

- What is the same and different about....?
- What stays the same and what changes?
- Sort or organise the following to ....
- Alter an aspect of something to see an effect.
- If we change.....what will happen?
- What follows from this?
- What do you think will happen next if we do....?
- What do you notice about ....?
- When is it true?
- Is it just sometimes true or always true? Why?

## Other ways to help your child include:

## Use everyday opportunities to make mathematics visible

- Remember your child's learning may look different to yours.
- There can be a number of ways to solve a mathematical problem.
- Don't say "That's wrong", say "How did you get your answer?"
- Encourage your child to talk through their thinking
- Allow your child time to think don't rush in and give them the answer wait and listen.

# Parking Rules & Penalties

## Council's Compliance Officers enforce parking signs at your school.

When it comes to the safety of vulnerable road users like school children, drivers found breaking the law will be met with zero tolerance. **When an offence is detected, you will be fined.** 



NO STOPPING You must not STOP at any time. Stopping includes when the vehicle is not moving but the engine is still running.

SCHOOL ZONE
Penalty from $344 and 2 demerit points
```



#### **NO PARKING**

You can stop only to drop off or pick up passengers or goods and you must not stop for more than 2 minutes and The driver must stay within 3 metres of your vehicle. Stopping includes

when the vehicle is not moving but the engine is still running.

SCHOOL ZONE Penalty from \$191 and 2 demerit points



**BUS ZONES** You must not stop your vehicle in a Bus Zone unless you are driving a public bus. Stopping includes when the vehicle is not moving but the engine is still running.

SCHOOL ZONE Penalty from \$344 and 2 demerit points



### DRIVEWAYS

You must not park your car over or block access to a driveway. You can stop in a driveway to drop off or pick up passengers BUT only for less than 2 minutes AND the driver must stay with the car.

## There are now increased penalties and demerit points associated with all offences in School Zones.

	<b>NO PARKING</b> You have no more than 2 minutes for drop-offs or pick-ups and must stay within 3 metres of your vehicle.	Penalty from \$191 and 2 demerit points
NO STOPPING	<b>NO STOPPING</b> Under no cicumstances are you permitted to stop on a length of road to which a No Stopping Sign applies.	Penalty from \$344 and 2 demerit points
	<b>BUS ZONE</b> You must not stop your vehicle in the indicated zone unless you are driving a public bus.	Penalty from \$344 and 2 demerit points

Stop on path or nature strip	\$344 & 2 demerit points
Stop on / near marked pedestrian/children's crossing	\$457 & 2 demerit points
Approach children's crossing too guickly to stop safely	\$572 & 4 demerit points

Stop across driveway	\$344 & 2 demerit points
Drive using a hand held mobile phone	\$457 & 5 demerit points

### Regional Fox Baiting Program

Please be advised that a fox baiting program will soon commence in the local area in conjunction with Greater Sydney Local Land Services. The aim of the program is to protect native wildlife including threatened species from fox predation.

1080 poison baits will be laid in the following Reserves:

- Excelsior Reserve, North Rocks;
- Ted Horwood Reserve, Baulkham Hills;
- Eric Mobbs Reserve, Castle Hill; and
- Holland Road Reserve, Glenhaven.

#### Foxoff® poison or meat baits (containing 1080)

#### will be buried in the above listed reserves between

### Monday 24<sup>th</sup> February – Friday 13<sup>th</sup> March 2020

Foxoff<sup>®</sup> is designed specifically for fox control. Trained staff will undertake the baiting. Baits will be buried 10cm under the ground to reduce the risk of non-target poisoning.

### WARNING:

- 1080 poison is lethal to dogs and cats
- The above listed bushland reserves will be closed to dogs (including dogs walking on a lead), during and up to 4 weeks after the fox baiting program.
- Dogs on leads can return to these reserves on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> April 2020.

Signs stating "1080 FOX POISON LAID IN THIS AREA" and "Dogs (& Cats) are prohibited" will be displayed in the relevant parks and reserves to notify the public about the program.
