



OUR LADY OF LOURDES, BAULKHAM HILLS SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

PURPOSE

The wearing of our school uniform plays an important role in instilling pride in the children and maintaining our school identity and spirit. This Uniform Policy clearly states our school expectations for parents and encourages students to consistently wear the correct uniform.

BROAD GUIDELINES

UNIFORM

- *Children are to wear the correct school uniform neatly and with pride and are not to deviate from items on the School Uniform list.*
- *All items of clothing must be marked clearly with the child's full name. Shoes and sports shoes can be marked on the inside with a waterproof marker. The school can not accept the responsibility for items that are lost.*

Summer Uniform

Girls

- School summer dress
- Short visible grey socks
- Black Shoes

Boys

- Short sleeve blue crested shirt
- School navy blue shorts
- Grey visible short socks
- Black shoes

Sports Uniform

- School crested shorts
- School crested white shirt
- Short visible white socks
- Predominantly white Joggers or sandshoes
- Navy tracksuit (worn as whole on sports days only)
- The Year six children may purchase a 'Year Six Sport Polo' in the school colours. These may be worn by Year Six on sport days.

Winter Uniform

Girls

- Blue/Grey checked tunic
- Long -sleeved Blue blouse
- Checked "tab tie"
- Navy Blue Girls Slacks (Optional)
- Grey tights or long grey socks
- Black shoes
- Navy school zip Jacket

Boys

- Long sleeve blue crested shirt
- School tie
- Navy Blue school trousers
- Grey socks
- Black shoes
- Navy school Jacket

Miscellaneous Items

- School bag or suitable school bag
- Library bag

School Hat

The school hat **must** be worn by all students during break times and sport activities. Students without a hat will be asked to **sit** in a shaded area.

Jewellery

Children are not permitted to wear jewellery except for plain sleepers/stud earrings. A single necklace of a religious nature may be worn but because of safety issues and the potential to lose valuable items, this should be worn under the child's shirt.

Hair

Hair must be kept neat and tidy at all times. Shoulder length hair and longer must be tied back at all times. Head bands, hair ties and scrunchies are to be in school colours.

- Hairstyles are to be neat and simple and devoid of any type of cosmetic colouring.
- No part of the hair should be cut shorter than a "Number 2"
- Undercuts, tracts, lines, shapes or any other patterns cut into the hair is not permitted
- No coloured gel products are permitted or other other grooming products that hinder the wearing of the school hat, i.e. gel used to spike up hair which you cannot place your school hat over
- Hair accessories must be modest in size and appearance and in the school colours only
- Tropical holiday beading and braiding is to be removed within **one week** of returning to school
